ABOUT LA MARTINIERE COLLEGE, LUCKNOW

La Martinière College was founded in 1845. La Martiniere Boys' College is the only school in the world to have been awarded royal battle honours for its role in the defence of Lucknow and the Lucknow residency during the Indian Rebellion of 1857.

The La Martinière College was, founded by the French adventurer Major General Claude Martin. La Martinière provides a liberal education and the medium of instruction is the English language. The schools cater for pupils from the age of 5 to 17 or 18, and are open to children of all religious denominations, the boys' school has a Chapel, a Hindu Temple and a Mosque on its campus and has remained a non-denominational school since its inception.

The College consists of a magnificent eighteenth-century building, to which other imposing structures have been periodically added. Constantia, the imposing Centre-point of La Martiniere, was designed as a country house of Major-General Claude Martin. He willed that he be buried in the crypt of the building.

Presentation: Teams will have 2 to 5 minutes to explain their project.

Blueprint Submission: Teams are required to submit the blueprints of their project within 10 days of registration.
